Food Truck Terms and Conditions

St. Leonard requires that all food truck/vendors abide by the following terms and conditions. Failure to do so may result in exclusion from the BoomerFest.

- Food Trucks/vendors will supply all materials and equipment needed for the space set-up
- Food Trucks/Vendors must comply with parking instructions upon arrival to BoomerFest
- Food Trucks/Vendors must enter our campus using the Clio Rd. entrance and parking attendants will direct you from there Food Trucks/Vendors must comply with set-up and tear-down times
- Food Trucks/Vendors must be set up no later than 11:00am on August 13.
- Food Trucks/Vendors may close after 9:00pm
- Food Trucks/Vendors may sell beverages and those must be non-alcoholic
- Food Truck/vendors are responsible for removing all trash from their space leaving it as they found it when they arrived
- All Food Truck/Vendors must comply with and are solely responsible for any State, County or City permits needed to sell their products
- No refunds will be issued
- St. Leonard is a non-smoking campus
- No open flames such as candles, lanterns, kerosene or gas-fired heaters and cooking equipment are permitted near or under combustible materials
- St. Leonard reserves the right to deny any Food Truck/Vendor from participating in the BoomerFest if their products or services are not in alignment with our company values
